

Luxembourg is a world-renowned international business location and a secure and reliable hub for cross-border activities in a number of fields, including the digital economy, finance, logistics, space technologies, smart mobility, health technologies and clean technologies. The country is situated at the heart of several major EU markets. Global players of all sizes use Luxembourg as a gateway to Europe and beyond, benefiting from its closeness to decision-making centres and its excellent access to worldwide markets.

Luxembourg is known for its economic and political stability as well as for its strong long-term growth prospects. One reason for its success is its ability to react quickly to new opportunities. It is the first country in the world to embrace Jeremy Rifkin's blueprint for a third industrial revolution designed to ensure a resilient and sustainable economy by 2050, thanks to a fully interconnected ecosystem encompassing intelligent transport, renewable energy and new communications technology. It is also at the forefront of integrating the

principles of the circular economy into public procurement procedures. Its financial services industry leads the world in the listing of green bonds and is first in establishing itself as a hub for climate finance.

Already a global leader in satellite communications and broadcasting, Luxembourg has taken an audacious step towards becoming a major player in the management and use of space resources for the benefit of humankind. Building on decade-long experience in mining, finance and space, the country has developed a suitable legal framework to allow this to happen and is today a European hub for commercial space activities.

This characteristic openness and willingness to test new innovative solutions, as well as the diversity of its population and physical environments, make Luxembourg an attractive "living lab" to develop new products and services.





A uniquely attractive business environment

Doing business in Luxembourg is simple. Successive governments willing to dialogue with companies have developed a favourable legal and regulatory environment State-of-the-art infrastructures, excellent connectivity to markets and a strong reputation for commercial and political neutrality make Luxembourg an ideal place for international business to grow.

As a result, the world's largest steelmaker ArcelorMittal, satellite communication giant SES, automotive components maker Delphi, chocolatier Ferrero, tech firms Amazon, PayPal and eBay, as well as RTL Group, the leading European radio and TV broadcaster, and Cargolux, the world's leading all-cargo carrier, have chosen Luxembourg as a location for their global or European headquarters. Luxembourg is also home to a vibrant and international start-up community. Numerous support measures for start-ups, from incubation to success and acceleration, are available and incubators and co-working spaces offer premises both to newly created firms and to international companies looking for their first foothold in Luxembourg.

As one of the world's leading and most international financial centres, Luxembourg offers excellent access to private financing as well as specific financial vehicles to structure private equity investments. Companies can also benefit from attractive public funding programmes that help them expand their activities and strengthen their competitiveness.

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A magnet for talent

Luxembourg has an exceptionally skilled workforce and attracts both talented expats and cross-border commuters. It is one of the most international countries in the world with 47% of the population being non-Luxembourgish. Cross-border thinking, mobility and the cosmopolitan nature of its working population contribute to the country's high productivity. Due to the language skills of the workforce – fluency in three or more languages is the norm rather than the exception – companies speak their customers' language, a significant advantage. German, French and Luxembourgish are official languages and English is also widely spoken.


An innovation leader

Encouraging research, development and innovation is a national priority and the country invests heavily in both public and private research. Companies receive backing to help them develop innovative concepts, products and processes. Business-focused public research organizations collaborate with private businesses on R&D, product development and testing. Founded as recently as 2003, the University of Luxembourg today ranks among the world's top 250 universities.

Innovative activities such as biotechnology, fintech and the data-driven economy thrive in Luxembourg. The country has one of the best digital infrastructures in the world and plays a central role in the European network of high-performance computing currently being put in place. Its unique, business-oriented high-performance computer MeluXina became operational in spring 2021.

A cross-border specialist

Luxembourg's excellent air, road, rail and waterway infrastructure and its central location in Europe position the country as a competitive inter-continental logistics hub. Paris is two hours away by high-speed train, and regular flights to London, Barcelona, Zurich and Milan take about 90 minutes. Frankfurt, Brussels and Amsterdam are closer still. 60% of the EU's GDP can be reached by road in less than a day or by air in a couple of hours. With its first-rate infrastructure and well developed international distribution network, Luxembourg is an ideal platform for reaching the European market of 445 million consumers.



A great place to work and live

The national character of openness, dynamism and reliability is also reflected in Luxembourg's long tradition of welcoming foreign nationals and making them feel at home. With almost half of the national population and close to three quarters of the inhabitants of the capital coming from all over the world, a very international culture has developed. Well-respected international schools exist alongside public schools offering studies in Luxembourgish, German and French as well as programmes in English. The country's multinational makeup helps Luxembourg's politicians and entrepreneurs to understand their discussion and negotiation partners more easily and take on a mediation role whenever needed.

When it comes to career prospects, there is a world of opportunities in Luxembourg. The country has been voted a top-ranking place to live and work in multiple international surveys thanks to a stable economy, safe jobs and a generous social security system. Located in the beautiful green heartland of Europe and being exceptionally safe, Luxembourg is also a great place to live, travel and raise a family.



International higher education atmosphere in Luxembourg

The University of Luxembourg founded in 2003 is one of the youngest and most international universities in the world. Since its creation, the University of Luxembourg puts a focus on its multilingual and as well as in excellence in relevant research in targeted fields. It is definitely a modern institution with a personal atmosphere. It englobes 3 faculties, 3 interdisciplinary research centres and it counts around 6,700 students and 1,100 scientific and research staff.

In the yearly ranking Times Higher Education of young universities in the world, the University of the Grand Duchy ranks 20th.

Innovative and state-of-the-art infrastructure characterizes public research in Luxembourg

Since the 1980s, substantial reforms in the organization and governance of the research and innovation system in the Grand Duchy have led to a strong expansion of public research. Today, Luxembourg's public research ecosystem is defined by its internationalism, multiculturalism, state-of-the-art infrastructure and the consolidation of excellence in key innovative areas regarding fundamental and applied research.

Open access and science are other important features of the country's public research and innovation system. The mobility of researchers in the EU area and abroad is an essential feature of the Luxembourg innovation system ensuring high quality and performance in public research. In addition, Luxembourg offers an attractive and international environment for highly specialized researchers.



LUXEMBOURG PAVILION AT EXPO 2020 DUBAI

The Luxembourg Pavilion at EXPO 2020 DUBAI is a public private partnership between the Government of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, through the Ministry of the Economy and the Ministry of Mobility and Public Works, the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce, POST and SES.

Diamond sponsors ArcelorMittal, Cargolux and RAK Porcelain and Silver sponsors Guardian Glass, MCM Luxembourg, ULT and Schroeder Joailliers are supporting the pavilion presenting the Grand Duchy under the theme of "Resourceful Luxembourg", which is closely linked to the EXPO 2020 theme "Connecting Minds, Creating the Future".



The Luxembourg Pavilion

The architecture of the Luxembourg Pavilion located in the Opportunity District is based on the idea of a Möbius strip, an infinite form of a band with a single surface, which symbolizes the country's circular economy, its dynamism and openness. The ambulatory scenography of the pavilion showcases 5 key aspects of Luxembourg: diverse, connecting, sustainable, enterprising and beautiful.

The journey takes visitors through 5 thematic spaces: Luxembourg's diversity, its connectivity to the world, the country's entrepreneurial spirit, the far-reaching commitment to sustainability and the country's fondness of its traditions and beautiful nature. Every aspect is represented by a dedicated segment highlighting what drives the country, presenting the daily life of its inhabitants, as well as general information on the Grand Duchy and the various key sectors of its economy.

At the top of the pavilion, visitors enjoy a film on how Luxembourg has always succeeded in reinventing itself, going from an agricultural country to an industrial power and a global financial center with today a new change towards research, digital technologies and space industries.

A visit of the Luxembourg pavilion will appeal to all 5 senses. Sight will be appealed by the pavilion's architecture and scenography. During the exploration tour, visitors will listen to the sounds of the Luxembourg Philharmonic Orchestra and touch digital elements of the scenography. By the end of the tour, they will enjoy the smell of Luxembourg's lush woods thanks to the signature fragrance and the giant slide (a nod to the traditional *Schueberfouer*) will take them to the pavilion's restaurant where they can savour Luxembourg fusion cuisine prepared by the Michelin-starred chef Kim Kevin de Dood.



LUXEMBOURG **CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

■ The main mission of the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce is the protection of the interests of businesses and the Luxembourg economy. Today, it has 90,000 member companies, corresponding to 75% of total salaried employment and 80% of Luxembourg's GDP, making it the largest professional chamber representing the country's employers. Since membership of professional chambers is mandatory in Luxembourg, the Chamber of Commerce is highly representative. The Chamber of Commerce also works with the Office du Ducroire (ODL) to support Luxembourg businesses with export procedures by offering partial reimbursement of the costs associated with promotion, training, and participation in trade fairs, as well as insurance options for risks related to international transactions and investments abroad.

At Expo 2020 Dubai, the Luxembourg Pavilion will be a public-private partnership between the Government of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, the Ministry of the

Economy and the Ministry of Mobility and Public Works, the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce, POST and SES (Société Européenne des Satellites).

In addition to its sponsorship of the Luxembourg Pavilion, the Chamber of Commerce has set up an extensive economic program for Luxembourg companies to take part in Expo 2020 Dubai, including trade missions to showcase participating companies and key sectors of the Luxembourg economy.
