On January 7th, 2010, authorized by the State Council and jointly approved by General Administration of Customs of the Peoples Republic of China, Ministry of Finance, State Administration of Taxation, State Administration of Foreign Exchange, Henan Bonded logistics center was announced establishment. It is the only one dedicated logistic center in Henan province. Henan Bonded Logistics Center covers total area of 550,000 square meters and RMB 2 billions plan to be invested in 3 phases. 4 functional Zones Planning: bonded logistics center zone, functional service zone, comprehensive service zone, and special logistics trading zone. Recently it just applied the Ecommerce business in this center, so it looks for the proper partners.

Visit Xiaohongshu 小红书

Xiaohongshu, Aliases: **RED**, Little Red Book, an overseas shopping tip app. Xiaohongshu started its business by helping overseas travelers to draft a shopping list before they hit the roads. Launched in January 2014 as an app for people to review merchandise bought overseas, in just two years, it has attracted 15 million consumers and \$200m in annual merchandise sales. And already it's raised \$120m at a \$1bn valuation from investors such as TenCent, ZhenFund, GGV Capital and GSR. That's how fast businesses scale in the newly mobileconnected China.
