I have the pleasure to announce that the Chamber of Commerce of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg will organize a trade mission to Canada. The mission will take place in Montreal from March 16 to 18, 2015 in the framework of the Americana trade fair to which an accompanied visit will be organised. Because of this focus event, the delegation is meant to be comprised primarily of companies from the clean tech and innovation sectors as well as from the Business mentoring program of the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce.
