
I have the pleasure to announce that the Chamber of Commerce of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg in collaboration with the Ministry of the Economy will organise a multi-sectoral trade mission to Israel, which will last from the 24th to the 28th of October 2015.

Since the great success of the mission in 2012, Israel has further developed its status as world leader in a number of innovative sectors that are also key-sectors of the Luxembourg economy namely ICT, biotech, logistics and cleantech. As part of this trade mission to Israel, a seminar, dedicated to presenting the Luxembourg economy, its opportunities and its innovations – including a session more focused on smart cities and cybersecurity - will take place on October 25 in Tel Aviv.
