eBay & Privacy

- In the EU our two major Services' EU headquarters (that is, eBay and PayPal) are located in Luxembourg. eBay Europe S.à r.l. a Luxembourg company, and PayPal Europe S.à r.l. & Cie, S.C.A., is a Luxembourg bank. These are the legal entities that EU-based Users contract with to benefit from eBay services.
- eBay's privacy function operates an internal control system that aligns current and ex-ante legal requirements to our operating processes. This alignment occurs through a variety of change management, advocacy and executive oversight mechanisms.

- In our ecosystem, individuals choose to share personal information about themselves, in order to build trust with each other. Protecting personal data is fundamental, as increased protection encourages broader data exchange, a more efficient market and as such higher transaction volume.
- Our payments system PayPal allows consumers to pay for transactions without exposing their financial information. PayPal is the most privacy protective payment mechanism commercially available today, demonstrating that the principle of 'privacy by design' has economic value.

Substantiating BCR/applicable Law

- User data is under the control of eBay Europe SARL & PayPal Europe S.à r.l. & Cie, S.C.A so our BCR applicant in the EU is a Lux entity, and all applicable privacy law for user data is Lux. The definition of Controller is set out by A29 WP169 – the tests we defend are:
- Controller shall decide who shall be responsible for compliance: specified in interim / corp. structure
- Controller shall allocate responsibility: Lux entities discharge governance through linking Privacy role with Fiduciary responsibilities, Legal, ERM & IRM functions
- Allocation of responsibilities based upon factual influence: The privacy officer's
 role is formalised through a variety of consultative and sign off procedures across
 the functions i.e. marketing / contracts / escalated complaints + influence
 extended via other functions
- **Control stemming from implicit legal competence:** All EU users contract exclusively with Lux entities
- Determine purpose and means of processing: The general purpose and means of processing are set out in contract (UA / PP) – and controlled through various reporting processes adjudicated from Lux
