## World Expo Dubai 2020



The Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce is looking to optimise and diversify its impact on site during the six months of the World Expo. It will do so by organising several uni-sectoral trade missions that highlight specific sectors, in addition to a multisectoral trade mission around a dedicated ‘Luxembourg Day’ and a ‘Made in Luxembourg’ week. The Chamber of Commerce will link its sectoral missions to major international fairs (UAE Anchor Events) organised in the Dubai-Abu Dhabi region (e.g., Big Five, Gulfood, etc.), in order to take advantage of the World Expo and use the national pavilion to meet local contacts, and also to tap into networks of international fairs to facilitate sectoral networking.

Within International Affairs, a part of the team is also in charge of the Enterprise Europe Network-Luxembourg. The Enterprise Europe Network was created by the European Commission in 2008. With some 600 members represented in every region of the EU and in more than 60 countries all over the world, it represents the largest business support network to European SMEs. The Chamber of Commerce is the national coordinator of the network in Luxembourg. Within the framework of a strategic partnership, the Enterprise Europe Network – Luxembourg (EEN) is operated by the Chamber of Commerce, the Chamber of Skilled Crafts and Luxinnovation in order to offer Luxembourg SMEs a very large and diversified portfolio of specialised European business support services. The network’s goal is to provide companies with information and assistance in the context of the European integration process and help them understand the opportunities and challenges of the European Market and beyond. Personalised services are provided through tailor made assistance on European topics, internationalisation and innovation.
